2012 Election Information for Board of Directors and President-Elect

Elections for ATE Board of Directors positions and President-Elect (to take office after the February 2013 Annual Meeting in Atlanta) will be held in the spring of 2012. Applications will be considered at the February 2012 Annual Meeting in San Antonio when the Nominations and Elections Committee will present a proposed ballot to the Delegate Assembly for final approval.

The following positions are open:

President-Elect to take office as President-Elect at the end of the February 2013 Annual Meeting in Atlanta and as President at the end of the February 2014 Annual Meeting (any active member who has held Regular, Life, Retired or Distinguished membership for three consecutive years and who is or has been a member of the Board of Directors, a delegate, or a committee or commission member of the Association may make application for the office of President-Elect);

Board of Directors Council of Unit Presidents Representative, term through 2016 (open to any Active Member who has held a Regular, Life, Retired or Distinguished membership for three consecutive years and who has served or is serving in the Delegate Assembly or on a national committee or commission and who is working directly in teacher education at a college or university at the time of their election). In addition, the Council of Unit Presidents' representative must be a current or former officer of the Council of Unit Presidents.

Board of Directors College/University Representative, term through 2016 (open to any Active Member who has held a Regular, Life, Retired or Distinguished membership for three consecutive years and who has served or is serving in the Delegate Assembly or on a national committee or commission and who is working directly in teacher education at a college or university at the time of their election).

Two Board of Directors At Large Representatives, term through 2016 (open to any Active Member who has held a Regular, Life, Retired or Distinguished membership for three consecutive years and who has served or is serving in the Delegate Assembly or on a national standing committee, commission, or task force).

Instructions for Official Application for Elected Office**

Qualifications

A Board of Directors nominee must be a current member who has held a regular, life, or distinguished membership for three consecutive years **and** who has served or is serving in the Delegate Assembly, **or** on a national committee or commission.

A President-Elect nominee must be a current member who has held a regular, life, or distinguished membership for three consecutive years **and** who has been a member of the Board of Directors, Delegate Assembly, or on a national committee or commission.

Guidelines

There will be **no campaigning** pursuant to action of the Delegate Assembly (approximately 1996).

All candidates are expected to demonstrate active membership in ATE and to represent its ideals, purposes, and goals.
