

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ASSOCIATION OF TEACHER EDUCATORS

This corporation is formed in accordance with Virginia Code Section 13.1-801, et seq.

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is: ASSOCIATION OF TEACHER EDUCATORS.

SECOND: The period of duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The Corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for educational purposes in general to provide an opportunity for individual professional growth for all persons concerned with teacher education and to promote quality programs for teacher education. The Corporation shall also have such general powers as are set forth in The Virginia Non-Stock Corporation Act (Section 13.1-826).

FOURTH: The Corporation shall have five (5) classes of membership: Regular, Life, Distinguished, Retired and Student. The qualifications required for each class of membership and the respective rights of each class of membership, including the right to vote upon corporate matters, shall be as set forth in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

FIFTH:

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 4113 Lee Highway, which is in Arlington County, Virginia 22207 and the name of its initial Registered Agent at 4113 Lee Highway, Arlington County, Virginia, is George E. Cranwell, Esq. a Virginia resident, who meets the requirements of Virginia Code Section 13.1-833, by being a member of the Virginia State Bar.

SIXTH:

The Directors of the Corporation shall be elected and appointed in accordance with procedures set forth in the By-Laws, to comprise an Executive Board of Directors. The number of Directors shall be as set forth in the By-Laws but shall not be less than three (3) at any time.

SEVENTH:

The internal affairs of the Corporation shall be regulated and managed by the Executive Board of Directors. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation will inure to the benefit of any member or director. Should the Corporation ever be dissolved or cease to operate, in accordance with these Articles, the then existing assets of the Corporation will be distributed by the Executive Board of Directors to one or more organiza-

tions which are then operating as educational organizations holding a current Section 501(c)(3) status under the Internal Revenue Code, as amended.)
