2025 Nominee's Official Application for ATE Elected Office

The following positions are open for the upcoming election, which will be held in spring 2025:

- **Second Vice President** to take office following the certification of the 2025 election; they will become First Vice President following the 2026 Annual Meeting in Crystal City, Virginia; and begin their service as President at the end of the 2027 Annual Meeting.
- **At-Large Representative** to take office at the end of the spring 2026 Annual Meeting in Crystal City, Virginia and serve through 2029.
- **College / University Representative** to take office at the end of the spring 2026 Annual Meeting in Crystal City, Virginia and serve through 2029.

Qualifications

A **Second Vice President nominee** must be a current active member who has held a Regular, Life, Retired, or Distinguished membership for three consecutive years **and** who is or has been a member of the ATE Board of Directors, Delegate Assembly, or served on a national committee, commission, or task force.

An **At-Large Representative nominee** must be a current active member who has held a Regular, Life, Retired, or Distinguished membership for three consecutive years **and** who has served or is serving in the Delegate Assembly, or served on a national standing committee, commission, or task force.

A **College / University Representative nominee** must be a current active member who has held a Regular, Life, Retired, or Distinguished membership for three consecutive years **and** who has served or is serving in the Delegate Assembly, or served on a national standing committee, commission, or task force. Applicants for this position should be college or university personnel working directly in educator preparation at the time of the election.

Guidelines

There will be **no campaigning** pursuant to action by the Delegate Assembly. All candidates are expected to demonstrate active membership in ATE and to represent its ideals, purposes, and goals.

Anyone applying for nomination to elected office of the Association of Teacher Educators must submit their completed application material via the online Google Form linked below, and submit three signed letters of endorsements and a headshot photo by January 17, 2025 to:

Official letters of endorsement must contain **original signatures and be on letterhead**. Letters should be sent in **PDF format** directly from the letter-writer to ATE's Chief Executive Officer, [Alisa Chapman](mailto:achapman@ate1.org) (achapman@ate1.org).

Checklist for Completion of Application Packet | Deadline is January 17, 2025

___ One completed nominee official application (Google Form submission) that includes:

- a.) a statement of NO MORE THAN 200 words giving the applicant's position on significant issues confronting the Association. (This will be part of the nominee's information for the ATE Newsletter and ballot). The statement should be submitted via the Google Form application.
- b.) a biographical sketch of NO MORE THAN 100 words that recounts four or five significant accomplishments in teacher education. (This will be part of the nominee's information for the ATE Newsletter and ballot). The bio should be submitted via the Google Form application.

___ One clear electronic photograph that includes the nominee's head and shoulders in the frame. Please make sure the photograph's quality is of high-resolution and saved in JPG, PNG, or JPEG format for the ATE newsletter and ballot.

___ Three signed endorsements on letterhead must be e-mailed to [Alisa Chapman](mailto:achapman@ate1.org), ATE Chief Executive Officer (achapman@ate1.org) directly from the person providing the letter and the document should be in PDF format.

___ Arrange to attend ATE's 2025 Annual Meeting in New Orleans, LA (March 7-12, 2025).

___ Confirm interview time with Nominations and Elections Committee Chairperson.

Interview

All eligible candidates will be interviewed. Based on the Nominations and Elections Committee's schedule, interviews will take place January – March 2025.
