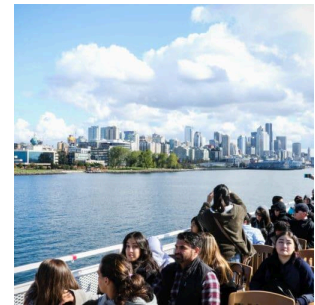
#### Puget Sound Cruise
