In 2010 the Lynn University community lost five students and two faculty members in the devastating Haiti Earthquake. One of the faculty members was my Dean of the School of Education. Upon this incident, I was charged with leading the School of Education. During this time, I took on responsibilities of the Dean including preparing for the State re-accreditation site visit which ended with a positive result. During this time, I attended recruiting and admissions events to meet with prospective students and families, oversee the budget, served as program director for multiple programs, and academic advisor. Throughout my career in higher education, at both Lynn University and Regis College, I have overseen curriculum changes, increased enrollment in all programs and increased retention and persistence. Giving back is at the core of my values. I have consistently been involved with efforts to support others. While working in Florida, I developed a tutoring program for children of farm workers in South Florida, organized collections and donations for socks, books, blankets, birthday party supplies, adopting families and serving on boards. In addition, I have developed partnerships with over 30 school districts which led to collaborating with them to determine teacher and para needs which led to the creation of professional development courses.
