Robert J. Stevenson Scholarship Award

Award Description

The **Robert J. Stevenson Scholarship** was established by the Leadership Foundation for Teacher Education (LFTE) of the Association of Teacher Educators, with major contributions from the Stevenson family. The scholarship supports a classroom teacher pursuing an advanced degree to strengthen teacher leadership skills through the study of teaching. This is an unrestricted scholarship—the \$1,200 award may be used for tuition, books, or other educational expenses. Recipients are expected to report back to the LFTE Advisory Council on how the scholarship was used to support their professional growth.

Award History

The scholarship was created to honor **Robert J. Stevenson's** enduring commitment to teacher education and leadership development, and to support classroom teachers advancing their education to expand their impact on the profession.

Eligibility and Expectations

- Must be a **current ATE member**
 - Must be enrolled as a **full- or part-time graduate student**
 - Must have a **minimum GPA of 3.0** (on a 4.0 scale)
 - Recipients are expected to **register for and attend** the ATE Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet in the year they are honored

Nomination and Application Process

A complete application must include:

1. **Letters of Recommendation (2)**
 - One letter must be from a current ATE member
 - Each letter must indicate how long the recommender has known the applicant and in what capacity
2. **Goal Statement**
 - One page outlining the applicant's future educational and career goals
3. **Official College Transcripts**
 - May be issued to the student but must come directly from the Registrar's Office
4. **Applicant Information**
 - Name
 - Home Address

- School Address
 - Email Address
 - Current Employer and Position
 - College/University attended (dates, number of credits, GPA)
 - College and Community Activities
 - Academic and Civic Honors

- Applications are reviewed by the Leadership Foundation for Teacher Education (LFTE) Advisory Council.
