

Transportation From Denver Airport to Denver Airport Rail

At a cost of \$10 each way, travelers can use the A Line to get from the airport to downtown Denver and vice versa, courtesy of the **Regional Transportation District (RTD)**, metro Denver's public transit provider.

The A Line, which opened on April 22, 2016, whisks travelers to the heart of downtown, specifically **Denver Union Station**, which is the city's transportation hub and "living room," thanks to its plush surroundings. From Union Station, travelers can access additional local and regional transportation services, such as light rail, regional and local buses, Amtrak rail service, taxis and the free 16th Street Mall shuttle (Mall Ride) and free downtown Metro Ride buses that provide access to most downtown hotels. Union Station itself is a beautiful 1914 Beaux-Arts building and the location of a number of hip, locally owned restaurants, bars, shops and a boutique hotel, **The Crawford Hotel**.

The Denver airport rail has six stops between the airport and Denver Union Station. The 23-mile ride takes approximately 37 minutes.

Where and How to Buy a Ticket

Follow the signs in the Airport to the A Line which is right outside the terminal. **Mobile ticketing** is the easiest way to buy tickets. The convenient app allows you to connect to other RTD resources for trip planning. Tickets can also be purchased on rail line platforms at ticket vending machines, inside DEN or Union Station, or at any RTD sales outlet.

For Uber or Lyft Passengers

Wait to request your ride until after you've claimed your luggage at baggage claim or have arrived on Level 5. Please use the designated crosswalks to access Island 5 and be aware of vehicle traffic in the area.

Ride app drivers are not allowed to solicit customers and payment is made in the mobile app. Rides may only be requested through the mobile apps.

Before you get into a ride app vehicle, make sure the license plate, car make and model, and driver name match what is in the app.

Rideshare passengers that require extra assistance can request a pickup at the curbside of Level 5 near doors 504, 506, 510 or 512 (west side) or doors 505, 507, 511 or 513 (east side).
